

Yarrow (Achillea millefolium)

Care: Full sun/partial shade. Water once a week first 5 <u>Care</u>: Full sun/partial shade. Water once a week first 5 months. Once established, water once a month or every months. Once established, water once a month or every other week. Benefits from root division every other year. Bloom season: Spring/Summer

Gumweed (Grindelia camporum)

Care: Full sun, water deeply I-3x a week. This plant goes Care: Full sun. Water Ix a week first 5 months. Once dormant in winter; stop watering during winter and cut established, water once a month or every other week. Bloom season: Spring-Fall

Coyote Mint (Monardella villosa)

Care: Full sun. Water once a week first 5 months. Once Care: Full sun/partial shade. Water once a week first 5 established, water once a month or every other week. months. Once established, water once a month or every other week. Bloom season: Spring-Fall

Depending on drainage, plants in your yard may need more or less water than we recommend. You do not want to overwater native plants, so experiment with how long your plants can last before beginning to wilt. After a couple years, your established natives may only need occasional summer watering.
